“Leading the UK fight to cut serious and organised crime”

- A visible new crime fighting agency with national and international reach.
- For the first time a single agency has the mandate, relationships and powers to bring the full weight of law enforcement to bear in cutting serious and organised crime in the UK.
- Intelligence-led, with a single intelligence picture.
- Tasking powers.
- Working with a wide range of partners (shared endeavour).
- Culture of openness and transparency.
- Relentless Disruption

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- Four Commands:
 - Organised Crime
 - Border Policing
 - Economic Crime
 - Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP)
- National Cyber Crime Unit
- Overseas Liaison Network of over 130 officers across 39 countries (plus Europol and INTERPOL)
- Single operational resource
- Intelligence Hub
- Specialist advice and support
- 5,000 officers (triple powers)

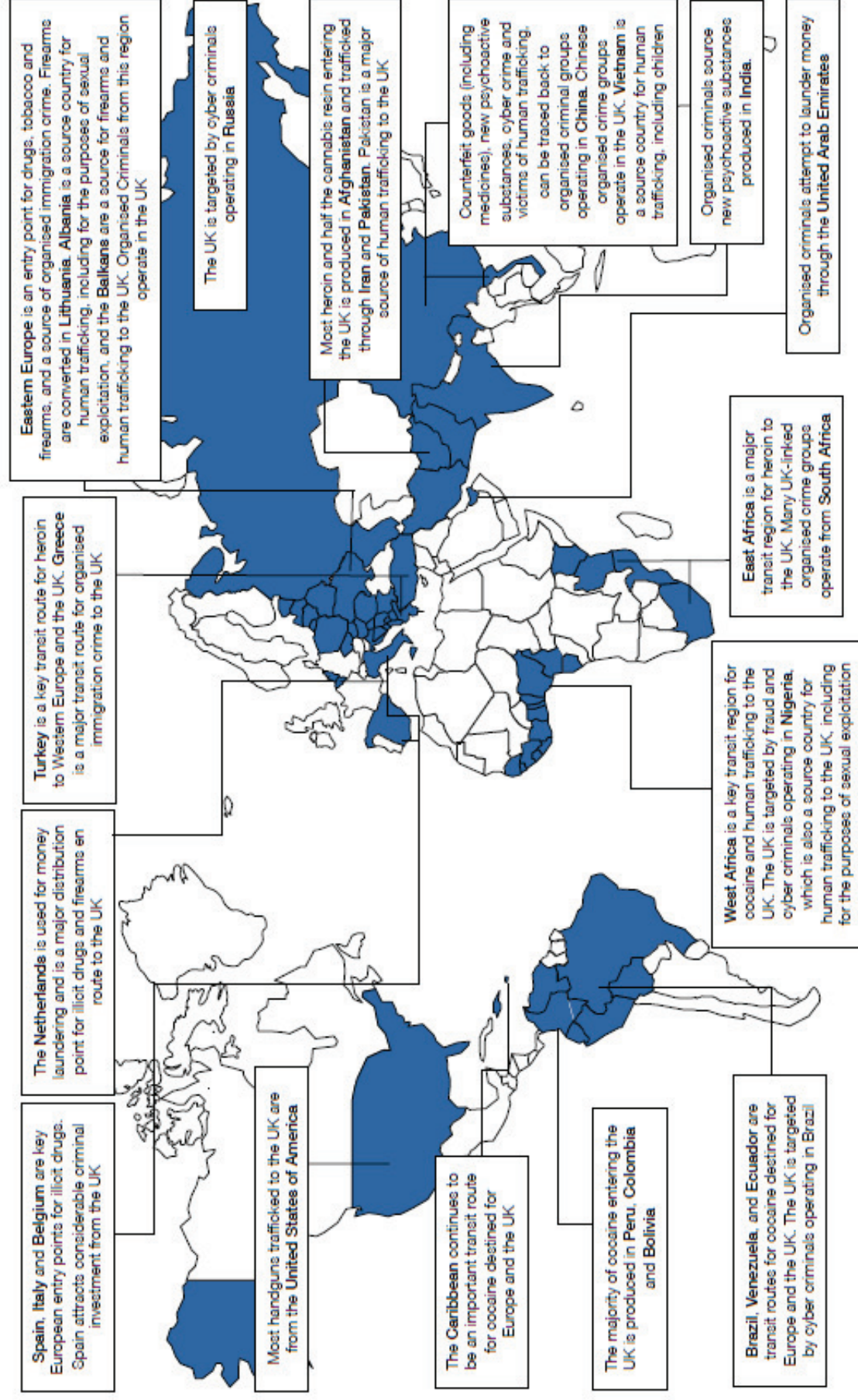




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‘The Reality’ Organised Crime Group Mapping

- We need more than a law enforcement / criminal justice response

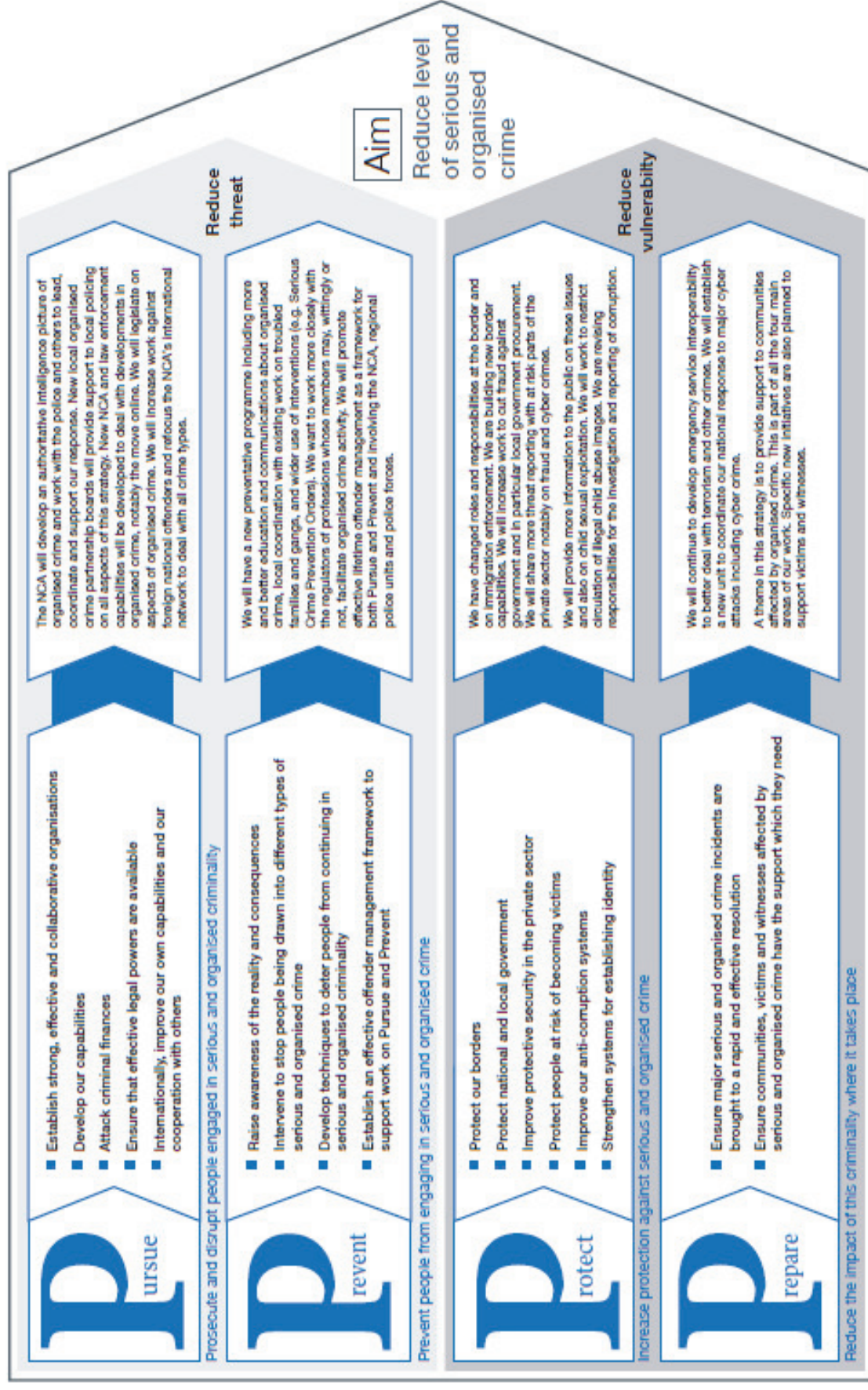
